

## #10. 4th September...Federal Candidates Update...Carbon Tax viewpoints of the parties.

As of 3rd September...

Conservative Party has confirmed 338 candidates for all ridings, including 105 women.

Liberal Party has 276 confirmed candidates or 80%, with 52% women.

NDP has nominated 180 candidates to date.

~14 potential candidates for New Brunswick have declared their intention to run as Green Party members.

The Candidate nomination deadline is 30th September
