

Baptism is a sacrament in the United Church of Canada and it is a joyous occasion. Baptism is a visible sign of God's choosing to reach out to human beings in love; to name them sons and daughters in Christ, and to invite them into relationship with God and one another.

In the baptism service, the person to be baptized (or the parents of an infant or child) affirm their acceptance of the basic tenets of our faith and offer promises related to their role within the community of faith, and, in the case of parents, promises related to their commitment to the care and upbringing of their child/children.

Adult baptisms are also performed at RHUC. All are welcome to explore baptism at Richmond Hill United Church - no requirement of membership for parents seeking baptism of infants and children.
